Health Screening May Include:

Complete Blood Count (CBC) detects a wide range of conditions such as anemia, infection, inflammation, and immune system response

Chemistry Tests screen for abnormal kidney and liver functions, as well as to check blood sugar and calcium levels

Electrolytes: an indicator for many conditions, including kidneys, diabetes, thyroid disease, and certain cancers

SDMA is a very sensitive kidney function test to identify kidney disease, common in cats

ProBNP Test to help diagnose congestive heart failure and other health conditions. 1 in 6 cats have undetected heart disease

Fecal DX to detect intestinal parasites which may be contagious to people and other pets

FeLV & FIV: 2 tests to detect Feline leukemia virus and Feline immunodeficiency virus

Heartworm is a blood parasite test to screen for heartworms spread by mosquitoes

Thyroid test (T4): Screens for hyperthyroidism, common in cats

Urinalysis to screen for urinary tract infections and other diseases, and to evaluate the kidney's ability to concentrate urine

Spec fPL provides the most useful information to support or exclude a diagnosis of pancreatitis
